

To whom it may concern,

I am providing the following COVID-19 vaccine exemption for pursuant to Revised Code of Washington (RCW) Section 49.60.030, *Freedom from discrimination – Declaration of civil rights*, which confirms my right to be free from discrimination “because of race, creed, color, national origin, citizenship or immigration status, sex, honorably discharged veteran or military status, sexual orientation, or the presence of any sensory, mental, or physical disability or the use of a trained dog guide or service animal by a person with a disability is recognized as and declared to be a civil right.” RCW Section 49.60.030(1)(a) confirms my “right to obtain and hold employment without discrimination.”

My creed prohibits me from injecting any mRNA vaccine into my body. My creed also prevents me from injecting any other form of medication, vaccination, or substance into my body without my written consent for an indefinite amount of time.

Furthermore, my creed prevents me from taking any form of COVID-19 test that cannot distinguish influenza from SARS-CoV-2 as well as any test that cannot distinguish SARS-CoV-2 from any of its variants. Additionally my creed prohibits me from being subjected to medical tests that are not medically certified tests or are not medically authorized tests.

To this I attest that I will not violate my creed by consenting to the receipt of the COVID-19 vaccine; nonetheless, I will do everything within my ability that does not violate my personal creed or my rights to help fight this pandemic in my scope of employment as a(n) _____ at _____.
